



NORWALK TEENS DRINK MORE THAN CT PEERS




Norwalk youth who drank were more likely to use marijuana & other drugs

THE MORE YOU KNOW...

- Kids who start drinking before age 15 are 4 times more likely to develop alcohol dependency.
- Each year that teens delay drinking reduces their likelihood of alcohol problems by 14%.
- CT's Social Host Law holds **YOU liable** if anyone who is underage drinks on your property.
- in Norwalk, **protective factors** differentiating non-drinkers from drinkers include: positive peer influence, high expectations, family support, or constructive use of time at home.
- In Norwalk, teens reporting **risk factors** such as vandalism, stealing, truancy, suicidality, depression, or disordered eating drank at higher rates,

• Don't let friends or family drive drunk! Norwalk's Wheels 2 U shuttle service operates a door-to-door service in central Norwalk for \$2 a ride on Thursday through Sunday evenings.

WHEELS

- Tell your teens to call you (or take an Uber) at any time of day or night if they don't have a safe ride home, no yelling & no questions asked. (Discuss it the next day when they're safe!)
- Text the Norwalk Police Department's anonymous tip line (274-637) if you know about an underage drinking event, someone providing alcohol to minors, or an impaired driver.

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
