1. Follow ups from last meeting

- a. Margaret & Diamond met with Community Services (Lt Dinho and Sgt Gulino) about connecting for both the alcohol and the MJ/vaping work
- b. Letter to Common Council on signage has not yet been drafted - **Diamond** will do

2. Plan for Thanksgiving

- a. Alcohol committee will work on delivering liquor stickers to participating alcohol retailers in the city.
- b. TNP will send press release.
- c. Signage for liquor stickers can include a QR code for alternative languages or to share more information.

3. Review alcohol info briefs

a. Potential Options for alcohol infobrief

- i. Since 2021 data shows that alcohol use decreased (because of the pandemic), it is a good idea to keep the 2018 data in the infobrief
- ii. Info brief must include information on laws, impact on the teen brain, perception of harm and parental influence
- iii. Info brief should be geared towards parents/adults
- iv. Diana mentioned that including post-lockdown data would be helpful
 1. Including information on modeling for parents that is culturally competent is necessary
- v. Tory mentioned that the environment in Norwalk does not speak to modeling safe behavior, because of parental norms.
- vi. Info briefs should be separated by substance
 1. A new marijuana info brief **MUST** be created because of the new law
